Saddle and Rubber Pad for 1526 Quick Lift Jack

This saddle is provided to you as an optional component. It is larger than the saddle originally shipped with the Quick Lift Jack, and it is equipped with a large, soft, rubber pad. If you wish to install this saddle on your jack, follow these instructions :

1. Close the release valve on the jack by turning the handle clockwise.



- 2. Pump the jack handle to raise the jack completely to its travel stops.
- 3. Position the jack on its side.

- 4. Use a snap ring pliers to remove the snap ring from the bottom of the saddle.
- 5. Remove the old saddle, and insert the new saddle with the rubber pad.
- 6. Install the snap ring, being careful to correctly seat the snap ring into the snap ring groove.
- 7. Position the jack back on its wheels. The jack is now ready for service.


