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

Explanation of Safety Signal Words



Lower Control Arm Bushing Removal and Installation

This tool set is designed for use on Honda lower control arms with press-in type bushings.

Removal

- 1. Remove the lower control arm from the vehicle following the vehicle manufacturer's service manual.
- 2. Clamp the control arm securely in a bench vice.
- Based on the bushing diameter, select the corresponding removal adapters and assemble as shown in Figures 1 and 2.
- 4. Tighten the forcing screw to remove bushing, see Figure 2.

Installation

- Clean the control arm and coat the bushing hole with a suitable lubricant.
- Insert the replacement bushing as straight as possible into the vehicle control arm.
- Select the same adapters that were used for the bushing removal and assemble as shown in Figures 3 and 4.
- 4. Tighten forcing screw slowly to ensure bushing is installing straight. Adjust as necessary. Continue turning forcing screw until bushing is centered within control arm. See Figure 4.
