

To use Google Cloud Print from Encore/Evolve


1. Ensure device is connected to internet and that network has unrestricted access to Google services.






3. Select the Share option and then select Cloud Print (web):




4. You will be redirected to the Google Sign In page:




5. Once logged in, you will be redirected to the default Google Cloud Print page which manages all of your printers:




6. Select "Cloud Ready Printers"



7. Select "Save to Google Drive", or a previously setup Cloud Print printer


